



Checklist for Obtaining a Driver's License

If you are under 16-18 years of age, passed the classroom portion of Driver's Ed, have completed all behind-the-wheel instruction, and have had your permit for 9 months, you are ready to get your Driver's License.

- 1) Schedule an appointment at the Secretary of State's office. www.ilsos.gov
The best way is to go online at 6:30 am as that is when the appointment times are posted.

- 2) IDENTIFICATION NEEDED
 - . Social Security Card
 - . Certified copy of your birth certificate or valid passport
 - . Something with your signature *can use social security card, passport*
 - . 2 documents with your current address *report card, bank statement, pay stub*
 - . Something with your parents' name and address on it *utility bill, mortgage or bank statement*

- 3) BRING WITH YOU
 - . Glasses or contacts if you wear them
 - . Your original driver's permit
 - . 50 hour driving log
 - . Proof of vehicle registration
 - . Proof of vehicle insurance
